

#### FIRST IMPRESSIONS COUNT

For this impressive facade, our brief was to update an existing lighting scheme.

The balustrade is exquisite handcarved Indian marble, which we wanted to accentuate. Previously, it was left without light, so at night was invisible. Our solution was to introduce Contour LED strip, to highlight the balustrade by night.
Balance is always important in lighting
so we ensured it blends in with the
rest of the scheme and does not
overpower any other element. We
completed the project with layers
of light, using both architectural and
decorative solutions including lanterns,
uplights and spike lighting to create
the full effect.



#### TAILORING LIGHT TO THE STYLE AND ARCHITECTURE OF THE PROPERTY

#### **KITCHEN LAYERING**

is used for the downlights to create
a trimless effect and provide a soft
illumination to the wall units. Contour
strip is concealed underneath the
cabinets for task lighting and Lucca
30s uplight the window reveal giving a
layer of accent light and drama.

Above we have created a layered scheme. Polespring 40 downlights are positioned around the kitchen countertop providing task lighting to surfaces. Contour strip integrated into the shelving. The scheme is complemented with oversized pendants over the dining table adding more drama to the space.






Good task lighting in bathrooms is essential around mirrors. A soft, flattering diffused light is created in these three bathrooms by backlighting the mirror. We carefully positioned Polespring 40 downlights to add emphasis to the basins. Decorative pendants were added to some of the schemes for elegance and to complement the architectural lighting.

#### TRANQUIL BEDROOMS

For this listed building, lighting is integrated into the joinery by the partition wall to light the space where downlights could not be installed. Contour strips front-light the joinery units, with decorative pendants lighting the mirror. Opposite, for a more contemporary look, Contour strip is cleverly concealed in the AC ducting above the bed creating a modern style. The playful opposites of both hanging decorative and table lamps add interest to the scheme.

#### CREATE AN OUTDOOR ROOM

Creating layers of light in a garden is as important as doing so inside. In these lighting schemes, our designers have lit the space to draw your eye through and highlight key features and planting whilst creating an inviting, cosy space to relax and enjoy the outside.





Brightness – Lumens (LM)

Lumens are a measure of visible light from a lamp source. The higher the lumens, the brighter the light. Across our full range, we optimise the light output for each product, allowing for full dimming to lower lumen levels.



#### **Colour Consistency – Binning**

When light fittings are in close proximity, consistency of colour is key. We only select from the closest matching colour batch (bin). Our LEDs are grouped, or binned, by how closely their colours match, by product as well as ranges.




#### Shades of White - Kelvin (K)

The warmth or tone of a light significantly affects the atmosphere of a space. 2700K produces the ideal level of warmth to create a welcoming environment in the home or 2400K to create a warmer glow at night. 3000K is used for a cooler, daytime feel.




#### Colour Rendition Index (CRI)

CRI measures the ability of a light to represent colour as nature intended. The higher the CRI, the closer it is to natural daylight. A low CRI light source in a wardrobe, for example may mean that navy blues and blacks are indistinguishable. **62**
